

This chart is gift from me to you, to thank you for visiting my website. It is a companion piece to the Mary Queen of Scots Sampler. The design is the Tudor Rose – emblem of England. But if you look carefully, you will see that the centre of the design is made of four thistles – the Emblem of Scotland, and the outer edge made of four Fleur de Lys – the emblem of France. The corners represent the orb and sceptre – symbols of Mary’s royalty in all three countries.

Materials list

The design is stitched in two strands of floss in a colour of your choice. It uses full cross stitches.

The design Area is 63 x 63 stitches.

Finished stitched area

14/28 count fabric 11.5 x 11.5 cm (4.5 x 4.5 inches).

16/32 count fabric 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches).
